

First Step Command - Testify: Mark 16:15

First Third - Look Back

Member Care: Ask everyone for their highs and lows for the week. Pray for the lows.

Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: Fishing: Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. **Following:** How did you do obeying Jesus?

If this is your first lesson, explain this portion for the next command and move on. Mark 1:16-18

Second Third - Look Up

Vision Casting: Mark 1:16-18. What are two things Jesus calls us to do from this passage? What did they leave? What does it mean to follow Jesus? What does it mean to fish for people?

New Lesson Read: The Gadarene from Mark 5:1-20 (Alternates: Luke 15:1-10, Acts 26)

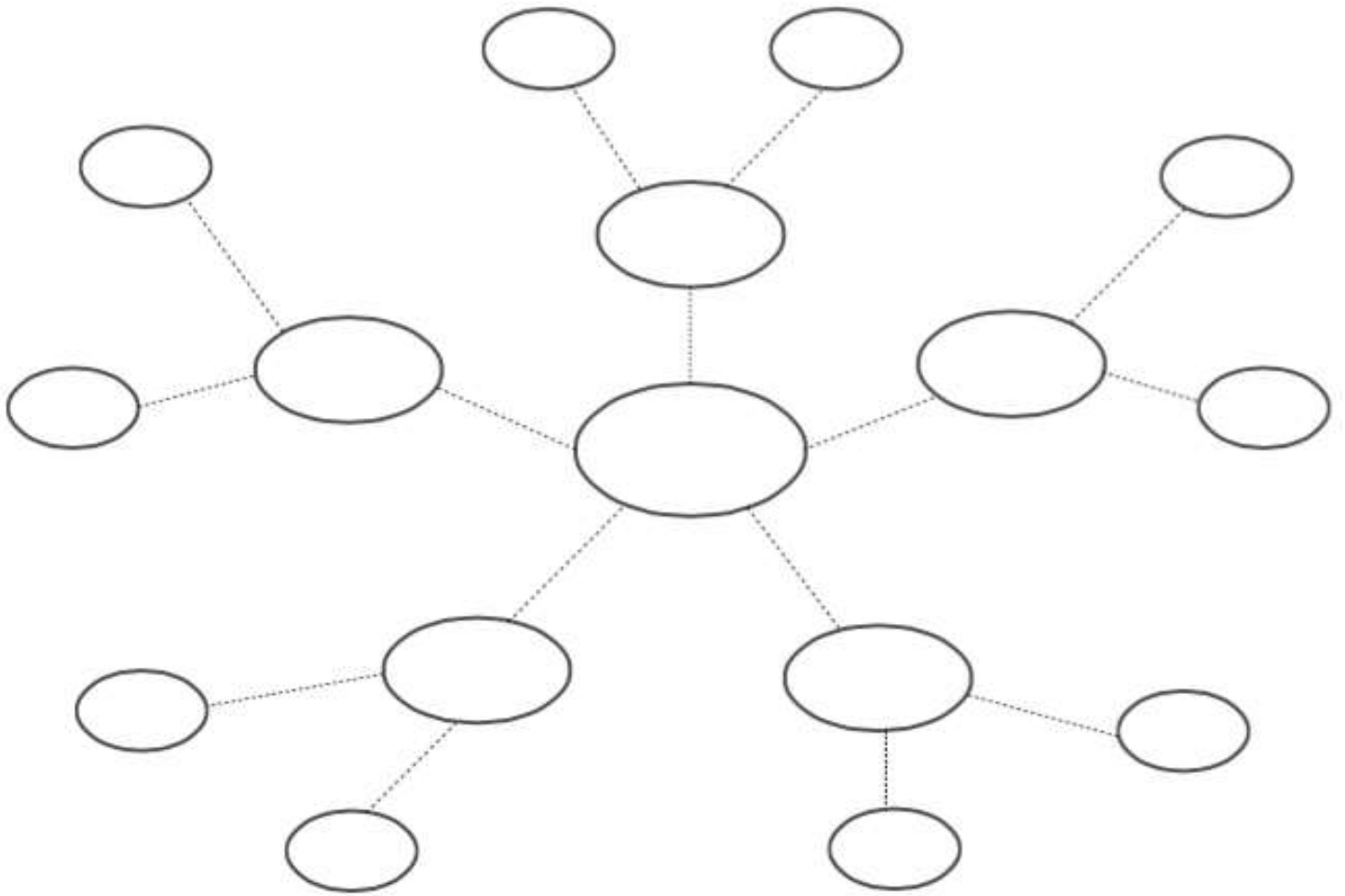
Head: Summary and Facts **Heart:** Emotions **Hands:** Response (Do you want Jesus to enter your life and control it like he did the Demoniac? Are you willing to share your story the way the Demoniac did?)

Who are your friends and family (the Greek word is Oikos)?

Final Third - Look Forward

Practice: A. Fill out your "Relational Network Map" below to help you see who you will begin sharing Jesus with.

1. Write your name in the circle that is in the center of the page.
2. Pray and then write the names of 5 people within your sphere of influence who you can begin sharing with.
3. After you write those 5 names, think about people who those 5 people can begin sharing with once they decide to follow Jesus. Write those names in the outer ring of circles.
4. Your map can be messy. Add more lines and draw symbols so that you know what you've shared with who. Keep your map in your Bible so that you remember to pray for these people everyday.
5. Begin looking for opportunities to share with these people (and with others as well) and refer back to your map to monitor your progress.

Goal Setting: Take one minute and quietly ask the Lord how He wants you to respond to His word.

Following: What will you do (actionable goal) because of this story?

Fishing: Start sharing your story with the people on your relational network map.

Command - Proclaim: Luke 10:8-9

First Third - Look Back

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Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: Fishing: Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. **Following:** How did you do obeying Jesus?

Second Third - Look Up

Vision Casting: Matthew 28:18-20

1. Does Jesus have all authority in your life?
2. Are you willing to go across the street or across the ocean to tell people about Jesus?
3. What's a disciple? Are you willing to be a disciple? Make disciples?
4. Are you willing to go to everybody regardless of who they are, what they do, or look like?
5. Are you willing to be baptized? To baptize others?
6. Are you willing to learn to obey Jesus? Are you willing to teach others to obey?

New Lesson Read: Mark 1:14-20 (Alternates: Matthew 10:1-14, Luke 15:1-10)

Head: Summary and Facts, **Heart:** Emotions, **Hands:** Response

Final Third - Look Forward

Practice: Practice telling the Two Kingdoms. First learn to draw it; then learn to share it orally.

Two Kingdoms: The truth is that there are two kingdoms in this world. The Kingdom of Darkness and the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom of Darkness is full of darkness, death, and destruction and the ruler of that kingdom is Satan. The Kingdom of God is full of life, light, and love and the ruler of that kingdom is Jesus Christ. Both of these kingdoms are eternal.

You: We only live a short time on earth and whichever kingdom we've served, we enter that kingdom forever. The Kingdom of Darkness will be destroyed along with all evil and sin, and all you have to do to be in the Kingdom of Darkness, is serve yourself.

Good News: The Good News is that Jesus Christ came and died on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins and rose from the dead so we could have a new life in the kingdom of God. If you give your life to Him today and serve Him as Lord you can live the rest of your life in the Kingdom of God.

Question/Command: Are you ready to receive forgiveness for your sins and serve Jesus as your King? If they're in Jesus' Kingdom, ask them to join you in sharing this message.



Goal Setting: Take one minute and quietly ask the Lord how He wants you to respond to His word.

Following: What will you do (practically actionable goal) because of this story?

Fishing: Who will you tell about Jesus?

Command - Baptize: Matthew 28:18-20

First Third - Look Back

Member Care: Ask everyone for their highs and lows for the week. Pray for the lows.

Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: Fishing: Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. **Following:** How did you do obeying Jesus?

Second Third - Look Up

Vision Casting: Matthew 28:18-20. What does the Authority of Jesus have to do with us obeying His Great Commission? Review your group multiplication strategy.

New Lesson: Read the story of Jesus' baptism from Matthew 3:13-17 (Alternate: Acts 8:26-40)

Head: Summary and Facts, **Heart:** Emotions, **Hands:** Response
Ask *each* person, "Have you been baptized in water by your own choice?"

Final Third - Look Forward

Practice: A. Practice baptizing each other by having them tell their story and then saying "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" and gently pretending to submerge your friend in water. For those who haven't been baptized of their own free will after their decision to let Christ rule their life, baptize them as soon as possible.

Goal Setting: Take one minute and quietly ask the Lord how He wants you to respond to His word.

Following: What will you do (practically actionable goal) because of this story?

Fishing: Who will you tell about Jesus?

Command - Abide: John 15:4

First Third - Look Back

Member Care: Ask everyone for their highs and lows for the week. Pray for the lows.

Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: **Fishing:** Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. **Following:** How did you do obeying Jesus?

Second Third - Look Up

Vision Casting: Acts 1:8. What do we receive? What is this for? Review your group multiplication strategy.

New Lesson: Read the story of the Vine and the Branches from John 15:1-11 (Alternates: John 10:1-16)

Head: Summary and Facts, **Heart:** Emotions, **Hands:** Response

If you have not answered these questions, ask these specifically: What are the two ways Jesus tells the disciples to abide? How do we do that?

Final Third - Look Forward

Practice: **A.** How would you help a new believer learn to pray? Practice teaching how to pray from the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:9-13 **B.** Make a list of things you believe Jesus wants you to pray for every day. You might start with the list of lost friends you already made. Start collecting Scripture to pray. Are you reading the Bible daily?

Goal Setting: Take one minute and quietly ask the Lord how He wants you to respond to His word.

Following: What will you do (practically actionable goal) because of this story? Spend time with Jesus daily reading the Bible and praying.

Fishing: Who will you tell about Jesus?

Command - Forgive: Matthew 6:12

First Third - Look Back

Member Care: Ask everyone for their highs and lows for the week. Pray for the lows.

Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: Fishing: Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. **Following:** How did you do obeying Jesus? Spending time with Jesus?

Second Third - Look Up

Vision Casting: Acts 1:8. Where were they supposed to be witnesses? What are your Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and ends of the earth? Review your group multiplication strategy.

New Lesson Read: Matthew 18:21-35 (Alternates: Matthew 6:12-15, Mark 11:25, Luke 23:24, Ephesians 4:32, Colossians 3:12-13)

Head: Summary and Facts, **Heart:** Emotions, **Hands:** Response

Final Third - Look Forward

Practice: **A.** Take some time to quietly ask the Lord if there is anyone you need to forgive. **B.** Pray through the "Forgiveness and Freedom Prayer" for that person. If the Lord did not speak to you about anyone, pick someone who you have had to forgive in the past and practice the "Forgiveness and Freedom Prayer" for them.

Goal Setting: Take one minute and quietly ask the Lord how He wants you to respond to His word.

Following: What will you do (practically actionable goal) because of this story? Spend time with Jesus daily reading the Bible and praying.

Fishing: Who will you tell about Jesus?

Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: **Fishing:** Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. **Following:** How did you do obeying Jesus? Spending time with Jesus?

Second Third - Look Up

Vision Casting: 2 Timothy 2:2. What was Timothy told to pass on? Who was he to pass it on to? Who were they to pass it on to? Review your group/church multiplication strategy.

New Lesson Read: Luke 10:25-37

Head: Summary and Facts, **Heart:** Emotions, **Hands:** Response

Final Third - Look Forward

Practice: Practice loving the people in your church by telling the 2 things you admire about them.

Goal Setting: Take one minute and quietly ask the Lord how He wants you to respond to His word.

Following: What will you do (practically actionable goal) because of this story? Spend time with Jesus daily in the Word and prayer.

Fishing: Who will you tell about Jesus?

Command - Assemble: John 13:34-35

First Third - Look Back

Member Care: Ask everyone for their highs and lows for the week. Pray for the lows.

Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: **Fishing:** Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. Ask everyone about meeting their neighbors. **Following:** How did you do obeying Jesus? Spending time with Jesus?

Second Third - Look Up

Vision Casting: 2 Timothy 2:2. What are the four generations in this verse? Review your group/church multiplication strategy.

New Lesson Read: Acts 2:41-47

Head: Summary and Facts, **Heart:** Emotions, **Hands:** Response
(What do the new disciples commit to in fellowship? Does Jesus believe your group is a church? Will you and your group commit to being a church?)

Final Third - Look Forward

Practice: **A.** As a group ask the Holy Spirit how you can follow the early Church's example in these verses. Make actionable goals for next week and/or next month. **B.** Commit to take up a one-time offering next week. Decide who your church wants to bless this month. Next week, take up an offering for the mission, church, group, or person you want to bless. **C.** Practice the Lord's Supper from 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 as a church. Pass out bread (the body of Jesus) and juice or wine (the blood of Jesus). Pray and thank God for Jesus Christ.

Goal Setting: Take one minute and quietly ask the Lord how He wants you to respond to His word.

Following: What will you do (practically actionable goal) because of this story? Spend time with Jesus daily in the Word and prayer. Commit to loving each other as a church and those outside your church.

Fishing: Who will you tell about Jesus?

Command - Find a House of Peace: Luke 10:5

First Third - Look Back

Member Care: Ask everyone for their highs and lows for the week. Pray for the lows.

Worship and prayer: Ask *everyone* to think about something awesome about God, something awesome He's done, or something awesome He's taught you. Pray these things out in worship. 1 Corinthians 14:26

Loving Accountability: Fishing: Ask *everyone* how they did sharing about Jesus. **Following:** Ask everyone if they practiced an act of love for someone in their relational network and the church, shared the gospel, and spent time with Jesus daily in the Word and prayer.

Final Third - Look Forward

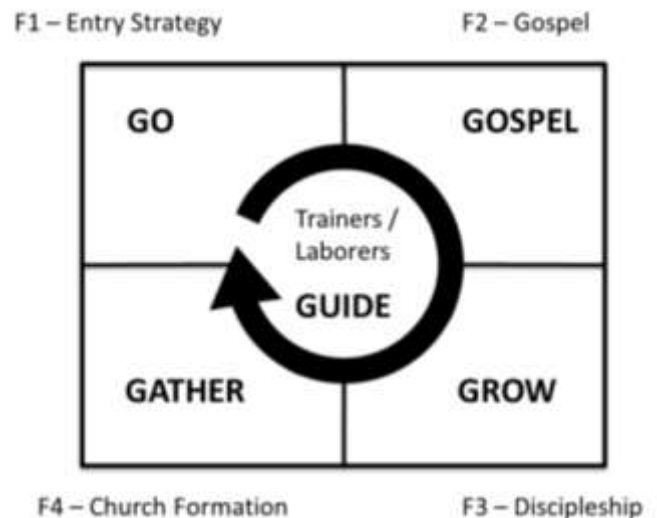
Practice: What is a person of peace? Should every believer search for persons of peace? What are some ways to search for people of peace?

Final Third - Look Forward

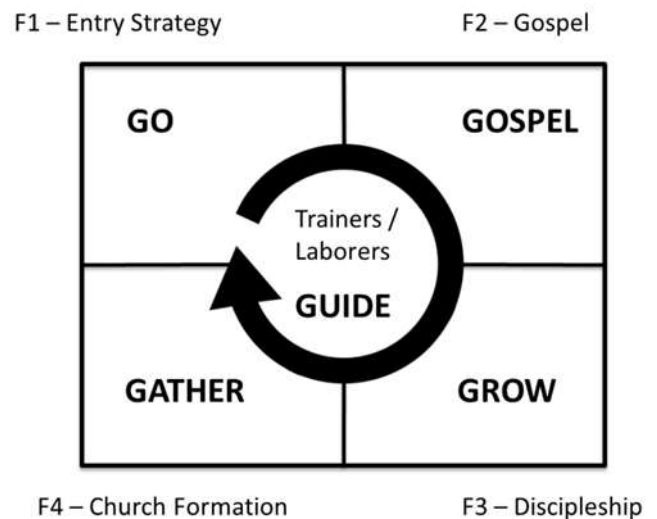
Practice: Spend 15 minutes in prayer as a group or church asking God to help you persevere in abiding in Christ, trials, and persecution.
